About Junior National Championships (JNC)

CSL Behring has invited Great Lakes Hemophilia Foundation (GLHF) to participate in the 2019 Getting' in the Game Junior National Championship on November 8-10 in Phoenix, AZ. Chapters throughout the United States have been asked to nominate two participants for golf, baseball, or swimming to represent them in the national competition. GLHF wants YOU to represent Wisconsin!

During the program, educational sessions will be available for parents and caregivers, and nominees will have the opportunity to:

- Participate in a clinic where they will learn the fundamentals baseball, golf, or swimming and enhance their skills in either sport;
- Learn about the importance of physical fitness in managing a bleeding disorder and receive instructions on proper stretching techniques and good athletic form;
- Show off their baseball, golf, or swimming abilities in a national competition with fellow participants from around the country;
- Connect and build relationships with fellow members of the bleeding disorder community.

Below is a description of the different skill building activities offered at JNC:

- Golf: Gettin' in the Game pro golfer Perry Parker will host a series of skill-building activities, such as putting, chipping, and driving, at the McCormick Ranch Golf Club.
- Baseball: Gettin' in the Game athletes Jesse Schrader and Peter Dyson will host a series of skill-building activities, such as pitching, hitting, and fielding, at Mountain Vista Park.
- Swimming: Gettin' in the Game athlete Tim Grams will host a series of skill-building activities, such as power and efficiency, sprint, controlled breathing activities, and streamline at the Stapley Aquatic Complex. <u>ALL swimmers must be able to swim 25 yards without assistance and be able to tread water for 30 seconds.</u>

Program & Travel Overview

*Nominees must be between the ages of 7-18 years of age, have a bleeding disorder and must be accompanied by an adult (parent or caregiver).

Travel Arrangements

CSL Behring will sponsor each chapter nominee and one accompanying adult to participate in the program. This sponsorship will include the coordination and cost of airfare, ground transportation in Phoenix, Arizona, and hotel arrangements (attendees are responsible for transportation to/from their hometown airport).

- o Nominees are asked to arrive by 12:00 pm on Friday, November 8, 2019
- o Nominees are free to depart any time on Sunday, November 10, 2019
- CSL Behring will cover the cost of one hotel room per chapter nominee, scheduled meals will be provided on site.

Application Process

- 1. Complete the following information and return to Great Lakes Hemophilia Foundation via email at kkoppen@glhf.org no later than July 24, 2019 at noon.
- 2. Nominees will be announced and submitted to CSL Behring no later than July 29, 2019.

Selection Process

- 1. Selection will be determined with strength of essay first, then whether or not the athlete has participated in the JNC before;
- 2. GLHF encourages all athletes to apply regardless of previous participation in the JNC;
- 3. A selection committee will make the nominee determination.
