2025 Highlights

- 47 families affected by bleeding disorders received scholarships to attend the Wisconsin Bleeding Disorders Conference

- Approximately 400 people attended Milwaukee's Best Bloody, GLHF's unique, signature event

- Partnered with the Gunderson Health System to bring 102 members of the Amish community to clinic visits

- GLHF's community advocates educated legislators and testified before the Wisconsin State Senate Health Committee about harmful insurance practices including PBMs & Copay Accumulator Adjuster Programs

- 49 camperships and 11 scholarships given

- Provided emergency assistance to 70 households (rent, utilities, medical bills, insurance), and 159 Medical ID Bracelets to patients with a bleeding disorder
